### Public Utility Commission of Texas to Hold 2023-24 Winter Weather Preparedness Work Session

---

**Austin, Texas** - The Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT) will hold a Winter Weather Preparedness Work Session on Friday, October 20, 2023, at 8 am CT in the Commissioners' Hearing Room at PUCT headquarters.

Commissioners will hear invited testimony from representatives with the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT), electric generators, and transmission providers on mandatory weatherization to ensure ERCOT grid reliability. Additional topics will include demand response and winter weather scenario modeling.

The work session will be live streamed by the PUCT.
