SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ADMINISTRATIVELY APPROVING REVISED CITY-PREFERRED ACCESS LINE RATES FOR FOUR CITIES

This Order administratively adopts city-preferred access line rates for four Texas municipalities (cities). Cities have been allowed, but not required, to raise their access line rates by as much as one-half the annual change in the most recent consumer price index (CPI), pursuant to TEX. LOC. GOV'T CODE § 283.055(g). This increase was calculated to be 1.15% in the Order Setting CPI-Adjusted Maximum Access Line Rates, approved March 21, 2002, filed March 28, 2002, and incorporated herein by reference. On May 8, 2002, having given Cities an opportunity to designate the rates they prefer to charge, the Commission issued its Order Approving City-Preferred Access Line Rates. In that same Order, the Commission delegated authority to Commission Staff to administratively approve, if necessary, a subsequent order incorporating revised rates for certain cities from which Staff continued to seek confirmation of preferred rates. On June 6, 2002, the undersigned issued such an order under that authority. Attachment A to that order contained the list of city-preferred rates which was intended to be complete. Since that order was issued, it has been determined that three villages (Creedmoor, Salado, and Wimberley) were inadvertently not listed. City-preferred rates for Eden were listed incorrectly. Attachment A to this order contains the city-preferred rates for the City of Eden, Villages of Creedmoor, Salado, and Wimberley. These city-preferred rates shall be applied prospectively and shall be implemented by certificated telecommunications providers (CTPs) no later than July 1, 2002.
